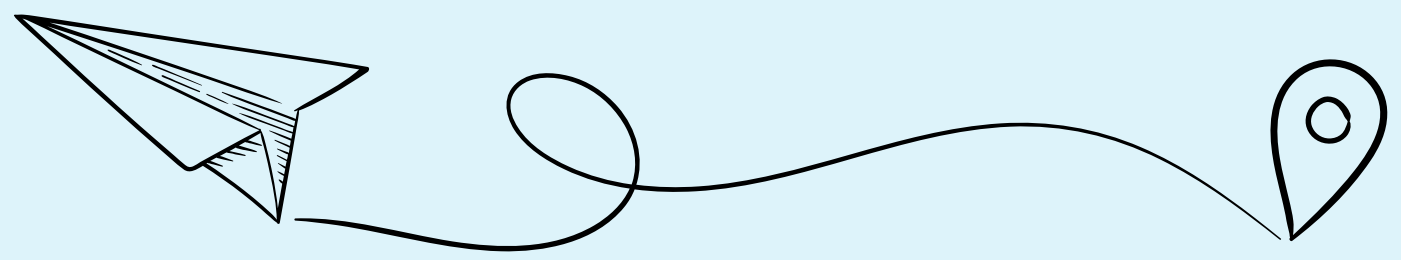

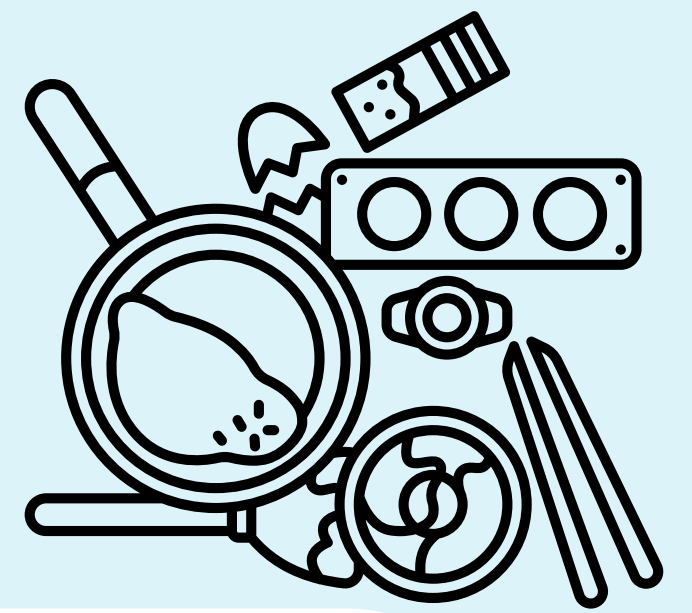

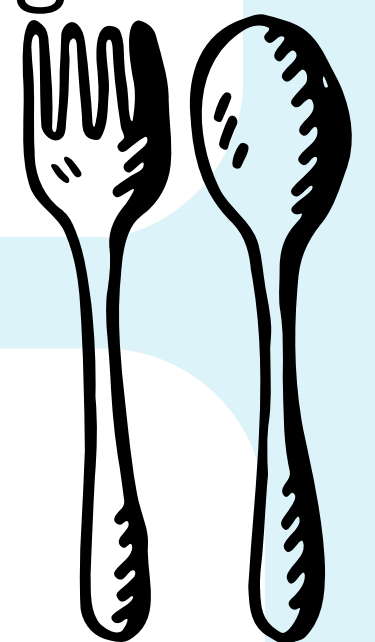
During this session, not only will students create different foods within the classroom, students will take a deeper dive in where and why different foods originated from and how they have changed throughout time.

During this time, students will also participate in water play days. Students will also take a field trip to a place that will allow students to gain the knowledge of being a chef as well as how to recreate certain foods!



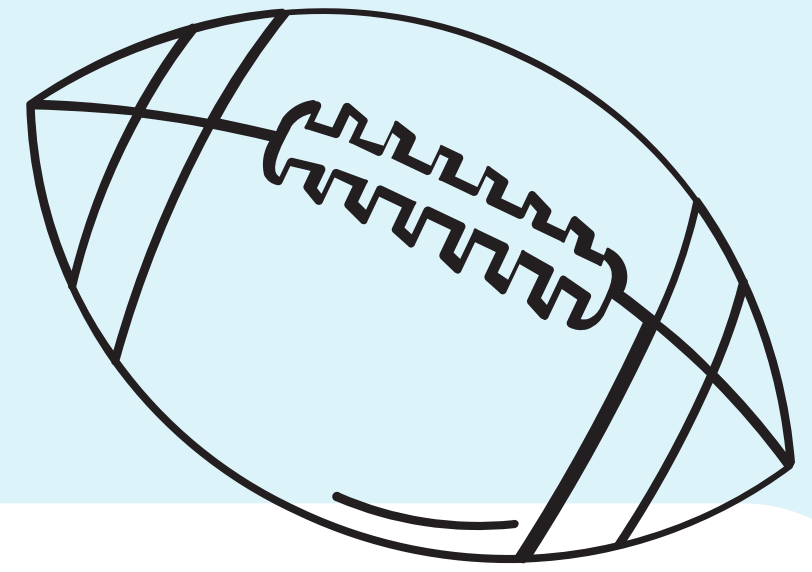

During this time, students will participate in water play days and engage those gross motor and fine motor skills by incorporating different sports and movement into their daily lessons!



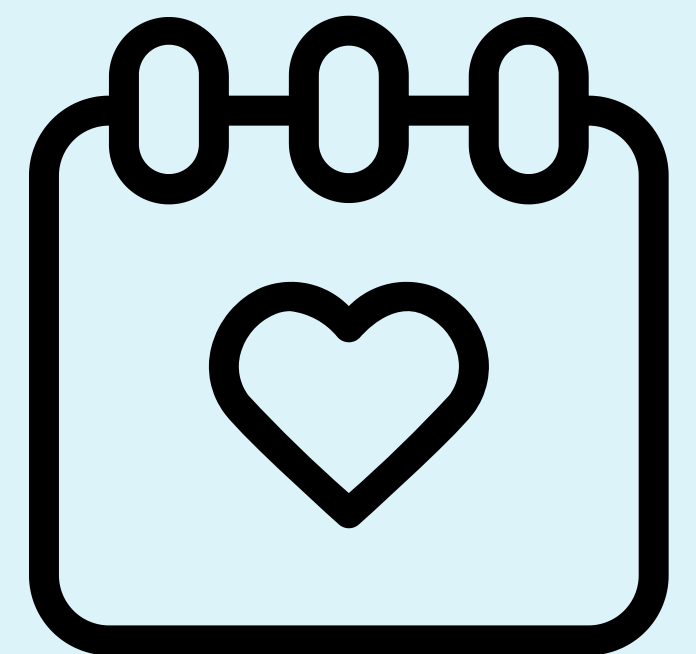
