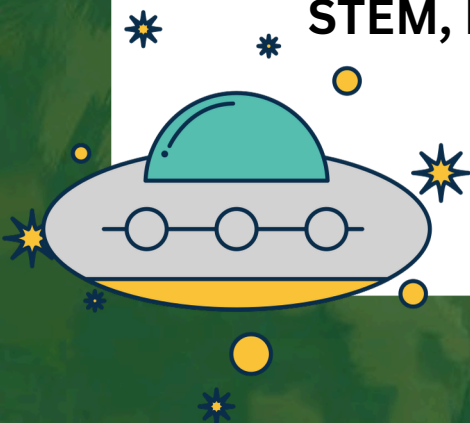


Session 1: Savvy Science June 23rd. - July 11th.

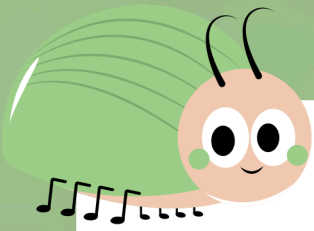
Session 2: Our Body Our Five Senses July 14th. - August 01st.

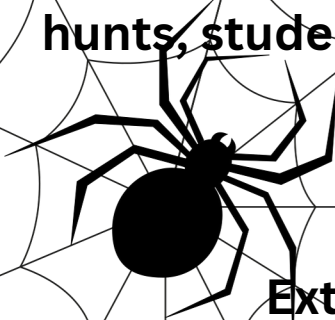


Session 3: “What’s Bugging You ?”

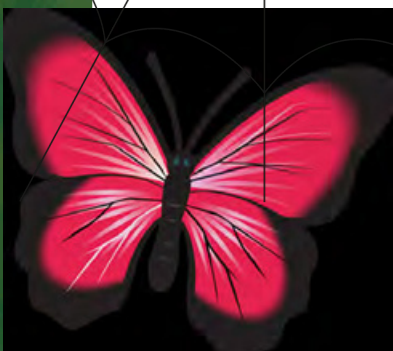
August 04th. - August 22nd.

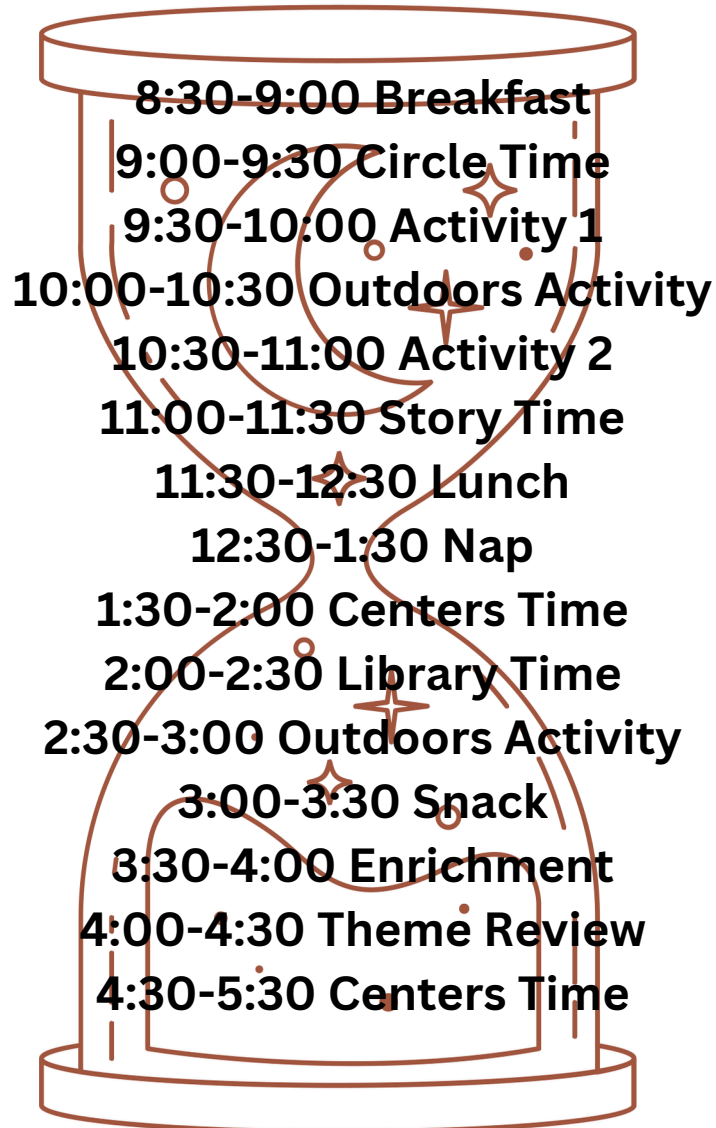
